

Dr Malcolm J Fisk, CoDirector of the Age Research Centre, Coventry University

Malcolm Fisk joined Coventry University in 2010 and has an extensive track record in research and practice relating to older people and assistive technologies. As well as leading the European Commission funded TeleSCoPE project (to develop a European Code of Practice for Telehealth Services - see www.telehealthcode.eu) Malcolm co-directs the university's new Age Research Centre. The Code being developed within the TeleSCoPE project establishes a framework for telehealth services for adoption throughout the EU. Importantly it seeks to encourage the adoption of perspectives that will change service paradigms in order to give greater control and choice to service users.

Malcolm is extensively published in this and related fields, and is a regular speaker throughout the UK and internationally. He was a Board member of the Telecare Services Association for 9 years, including four years as Chair. He also Chaired the National Partnership for Older People in Wales over more than four years. Now he is an Expert Advisor to the Welsh Government in relation to tackling poverty; and has been appointed to a Quality Standards Advisory Committee of NICE.
